



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Barton Springs/Edwards Aquifer Conservation District Board of Directors will hold a Public Hearing in a Special meeting by **Telephone and Videoconference on Thursday, July 9, 2020**. The Board Meeting will commence at 4:00 p.m.

The Public Hearing concerns a well drilling application filed by Gragg Tract LP, (1010 W. Martin Luther King Jr Blvd, Austin, Texas 78701) on February 11, 2020 for one new nonexempt well. The well is proposed to be discretely completed in the Lower Trinity aquifer, and is planned to be used as a public water supply well to support a future mixed use development along the FM 1626 and SH 45 corridor. A separate Production Permit Application will be required in order to operate and produce from this well in the future. The proposed well is located in Travis County on a 36.9 acre tract at FM 1626 (30.133597°, -97.860964°).
